

SCHS Protocol for the SPS Attendance and Uniform Policy

Attendance Policy:

- If a student is absent, they must submit a note to the attendance officer in the main office within the first **three days** of being absent in order for those absences to be excused.
- Absences will be excused for: student illness, medical appointment for the student, death in the family, observance of a religious holiday, court appearance for the student
- **5 unexcused** absences, including tardies, dismissals, and skipping, in a marking period = “NC” (No Credit) for passing students.
- “NC” student buyback will be during Thursday Night Detentions. Each Thursday night session will buy back one unexcused absence.
- Students with a N/C who do not buy back their absences, will receive a 59% at the end of the quarter if they are passing the class.
- Attendance and the buyback policy resets each quarter.

Student Uniform Compliance:

MONDAY - THURSDAY UNIFORM POLICY

- Appropriately fitting tan or black pants, skirts or shorts.
- Pants with a belt at waist.
- Appropriately fitting collared black polo, long or short buttoned dress shirt.
- Tucked in shirts and solid white or black undershirts.
- Knee length skirts and shorts.

FRIDAY UNIFORM POLICY

- All students may wear Central gear (Central athletic wear, Central t-shirts) as a top with uniform bottoms.
- Students may not wear Central hats or hoodies. No dressing up for school events Monday-Thursday.

Student Uniform Violations:

- Hats, scarves, coats, jackets, hooded sweatshirts, studded belts, or large belt buckles.
- Oversized, baggy, or ripped clothing of any kind.
- Baggies, cargo/khaki pants, jeans including black and/or skinny jeans, leggings, sweat suit pants, yoga pants, stretch or tight pants, jeggings, or pajamas
- Logos, insignias, pictures, or messages or clothing indicating a pattern (i.e gang affiliations).
- Gray coloring on uniform attire.
- flip-flops, sandals, slippers, or open-toed shoes of any kind.
- colored wrist bands, neck beads, head bands, or doo rags.
